About *The Temple of the People*

Founded in 1898 by Francia La Due and William H. Dower, The Temple of the People followed the line of the work of Madame Helena P. Blavatsky, who founded the Theosophical Society in 1875, and wrote *The Secret Doctrine*. In 1903, the Temple group moved from New York to Halcyon, California, where the Blue Star Memorial Temple was constructed in 1924.

The equilateral triangular shape of the Temple expresses the Trinity and the Higher Self. Its dimensions are based on sacred numbers and on spiritually significant shapes, such as the perfect cube.

“Our work is directed at helping all people who are hurting, who are searching — not just those who are interested in metaphysics or inclined to explore occultism.” (H. E. F.) The Temple of The People was organized with two principles in mind: to celebrate the unity of all life, and to further human brother/sisterhood on earth through its teachings of religion, science and economics.

The motto of The Temple of The People is:

“Creeds Disappear, Hearts Remain”

To fulfill its commitment to humanity, The Temple of The People has dedicated itself to the publication and dissemination of these truths.

Theogenesis

THEOGENESIS presents a third section of the Ancient Stanzas of Dzyan. The first two sections, *Cosmogogenesis* and *Anthropogenesis*, were published with commentaries by Madame Helena P. Blavatsky in *The Secret Doctrine*. THEOGENESIS continues in this tradition, with commentaries following each Stanza.

The current edition of THEOGENESIS also includes a selection of the writings of Dr. William H. Dower, co-founder of The Temple of the People. This section of 44 chapters, each with a separate index, contains *Occultism for Beginners*; *Biological Chemistry and Occult Relations*; *Evolutionary Waves*; and the *Basic Principle of Brotherhood*.
